Dear Parents / Carers

Below you will find our EYFS, Phonics and KS1 results for 2017.

Following all the new strategies that have been introduced we are really pleased to see that they are now taking effect. We are very pleased indeed with our phonics and EYFS scores this year. Staff across the school have continued to work very hard indeed raising standards and these results reflect that. We are particularly pleased with our continued rise of attainment from the previous 2 years in phonics and foundation stage scores given the emphasis we have placed on both this year and given the fact that they lay the foundations for improved attainment by the end of KS2.

Whilst maintaining our improving reading/writing and maths generally in KS1 we are particularly pleased with how our greater depth has increased and overtaken last year's national average. Our reading, writing and maths scores last year were in line with national and this year they are again either in line or exceeding last year's national average. The combined score for reading /writing and maths is greater than last year's for both pupil achieving expected and for those at greater depth and are exceeding national averages for 2016.

Below you will find the tables that show our children's attainment in 2017 compared to the national figures for 2016. We are still awaiting national figures for 2017.

We will let you know about our KS2 results when they come in.

EYFS exceeding attainment was higher in 2017 across all prime and specific areas than in 2016. The sustained rise in EYFS attainment and progress is a reflection of the changes to teaching and learning introduced in 2015.

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Phonics retest in year 2

19 pupils who did not pass phonics in Y1 were retested in Y2. 84% achieved the expected standard. This means 96% of the current year has now achieved the phonics score compared with the national figure for 2016 of 91%. The previous year it was 93% and 86% in 2015 which is a rise of 3%.
