

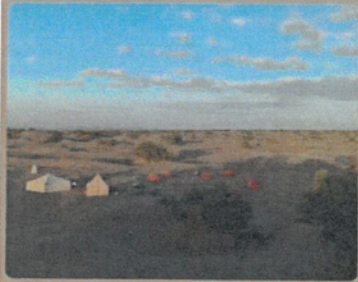
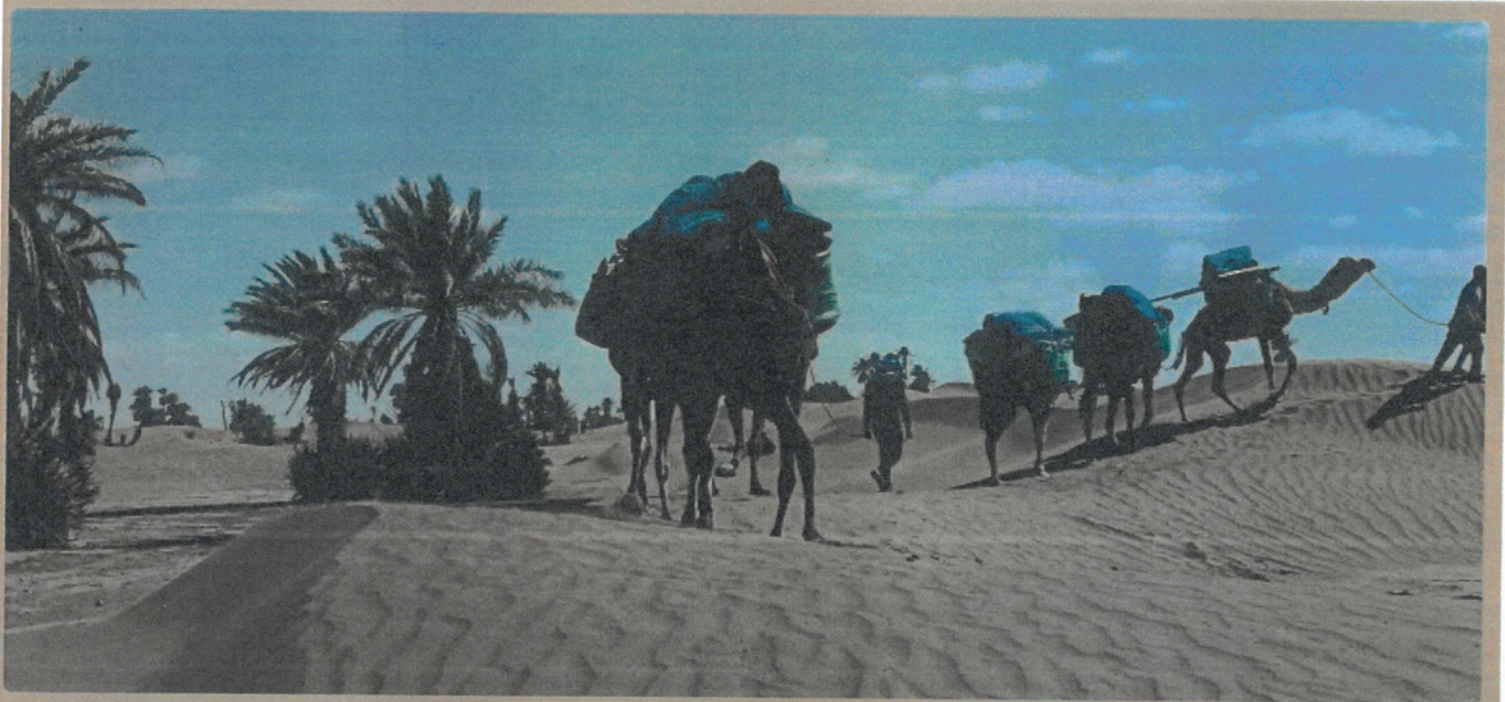


Easter Bonnet Parade
