

#### **Year 1 Victorian Day**

On Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November, Year 1 held an exciting Victorian Day. Activities included baking (and eating!) a Victoria sandwich, a visit from Deborah at Leominster Museum with lots of Victorian games and photos, practising handwriting with chalk on a chalkboard and having strict teachers! The children had such a fun and exciting day and they learned lots of new things.

In December Reception & Nursery learnt all about people who help us. They had some exciting visits from a Police Car, Fire Engine and a Paramedic. The children were all really excited and loved climbing into the vehicles. The fire fighters were even called out to go on a real emergency when they were here, so we got to see the blue lights and heard the sirens!

#### Year 2 Farm Day

On Tuesday 8th November, Year 2 had their Farm Day. We were very lucky to have had 2 tractors provided by Mrs Goode. The children loved looking at the 'old' and 'new' tractors and made some fantastic comparisons. They all decided they thought the newer tractor was better as it had bigger wheels and a roof! The children also had the opportunity to make their own butter and they couldn't believe how it was made from double cream. They were all shocked at how hard this was and much preferred buying their butter from a shop. Throughout the day, the children also explored where food comes from, how cows are milked and looked at a daily routine of a farmer.
