Year 4 Maya Day

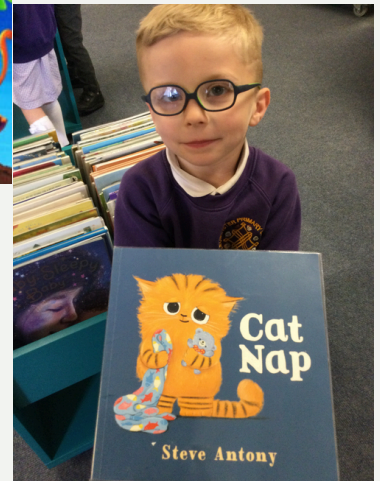
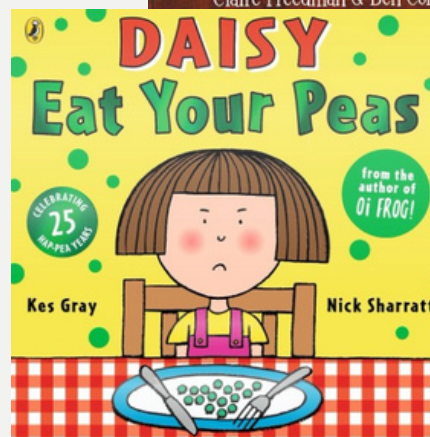
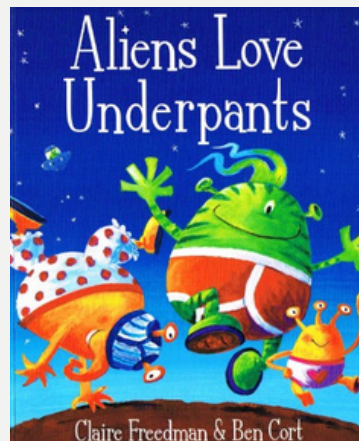

During the day, they also created their own Maya calendars, explored the fascinating Maya number system, and had the opportunity to investigate Maya artefacts. It was a memorable experience that brought history to life and inspired a real enthusiasm for learning.
