

Welcome to the Summer term at Nursery.







TOPIC

This half term we are finding out about animals. We have talked about pets, now we are looking at wild animals and next we are going to find out about sea creatures. The children are really interested in this topic. We are still continuing to practise fine motor skills such as cutting and pencil control alongside gross motor skills such as riding trikes and scooters, using stilts and ball skills.



As the weather is getting warmer, please remember to send your child with a named sun hat into nursery and apply sun cream in the mornings. Showers can also catch us out so can you send your child with a waterproof coat as well please.

BOOKS

We are going to send books to share on Mondays and Fridays. Please send your child with a book bag so they can choose a book. Book bags can be purchased from Club Sport in town and are useful for carrying work and pictures too. We will also be sending home a folder of rhymes so you and your child can say them at home.
