Out of 22 classes we only had **3** on target over **95%**, **11** Above **90%** and **8** below **90%**

Herefordshire Schools' attendance is 94.1%. This is above the national average of 93.7%. Our YTD attendance is a concern as we are below both of these at **92.8%**.

Illness- Should I send my child to School?

Reporting Absence

A polite reminder that all absences need to be reported by 9.30am on each day of your child's absence. We are recording a large amount of unauthorised codes at present as parents are not notifying the school. Remember these absences can lead to a referral to the local authority, which can lead to penalties and legal proceedings.

To Clarify:

All pupils need to be in school before registration at 8.50am. Anything after this time will be classed as late till 9.15am then unauthorised after this.

We still have several children arriving after this time causing disruption to the class routine. This is now being monitored and we will begin to liaise with families to offer support to improve this.
