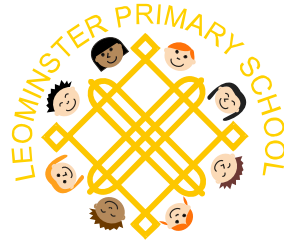


# Year 5 Autumn Term (2nd half) Homework
