Telling the Time Board Game

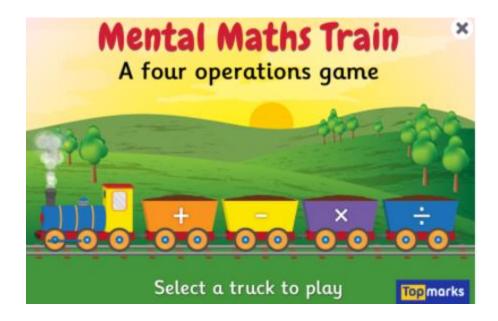
What time is it?




