## Highlights from last term ...



### Curriculum and topic this term:

**English:** This term the children will explore **fantasy stories** and will be given the opportunity to write their very own fantasy story. They will also be exploring the features of **non-chronological reports** and will write a non-chronological report on the importance of the river Nile to the Egyptians.

Maths: In mathematics this term, we will be focusing on 'Multiplication and Division', 'Area', 'Fractions' and 'Decimals'.

**Science:** We will be continuing with our current science topics and then beginning our new topic, **'States of matter'** later in the Spring term.

**Topic:** Our topic for this term is the '**Ancient Egyptians**'. Within this topic, the children will learn when events from Ancient Egypt took place; the importance of the River Nile and understand what life was like as an Ancient Egyptian. The children will also design and make their own Egyptian burial masks.

**R.E:** In R.E. this term, the children will be learning about the Hindu religion and what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today.

**French:** The children will complete 30 minutes of French a week focusing on a wide range of different topics.

PSHE: This term we will be focusing on 'Emergency situations' and 'Respect'.

### **Special Events**

#### <u>Egyptian Day</u>

On **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> January**, Year 4 are having an Egyptian themed day. The children will have the opportunity to mummify a tomato; decipher and create hieroglyphics and create some Egyptian artwork. The children can also dress up in Egyptian style clothes if they wish to, but this is not compulsory.



#### Western Power Production and Workshop

On **Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**, Western Power Distribution are coming into Leominster Primary School. Pupils will receive a theatrical assembly followed by workshops in the classrooms, where they will receive information on safety with electricity, the dangers and consequences as well as their responsibility to others.
