Firstly, we will be learning about phrases and vocabulary we can use in the classroom and then we will also be looking at French used when	Maths This half term, Year 4 will be continuing with their Fractions work and moving on to Decimals after that. Children will learn to identify and work with equivalent fractions, add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and start to explore the connection between fractions and decimals. Within decimals, children will learn about tenths and hundredths. They will learn to compare decimals with the same number of decimal places and find the effect of dividing by 10 and 100.
