#### Curriculum this term:

It is another very busy term with a lot to look forward to. We have many exciting things planned for both children and parents. There will be a wide range of extra-curricular clubs on offer.

The children are exploring 'Reviews and playscrips' in **English** and the focus is on them producing their own reviews to share with their class and a playscript they can perform. Later in the term, we will be focusing on writing 'Mythological stories' which links to our topic on Greeks

In **Mathematics** this term we will be following the objectives outlined in the National Curriculum. These can be found on the government website:

Our **Science** topics are 'Forces' and 'Earth and Space'. The children can start thinking about the different types of forces that exist and start reading about planets.

Our main topic this term will be **History** based, it's title is 'What have the Greeks done for us?' and we will be studying aspects of Greek life and linking it to our modern world.

The children will also have whole class reading, SPaG - spelling, punctuation and grammar, RE, PSHE, French, Computing, Art, PE and collective worship (daily). Any books, artefacts or information the children are able to bring into school would be very much appreciated

### Reminders:

Reading: Please try to read with your children as regularly as possible. We ask each child to read as often as possible - every evening, Monday to Thursday and record it in their reading record.
