- Find out about the different ways power stations generate electricity
- Find out about building and designing eco houses. Design your own eco house and label it with its energy saving features and sustainable materials. Perhaps you could make a model of your house?
- Produce a poster or leaflet with interesting facts about electricity. Think about animals, our bodies and the weather!
- Make a poster or leaflet about how to save electricity
