Topic: Ancient Greece

Your task this term is to research an aspect of *Ancient Greece*.

You could design a poster or leaflet, paint a picture, produce a PowerPoint, make a model, write a non-chronological report or even cook something inspired by Ancient Greece! What you do is your choice – but you may be inspired by some of the following ideas:

- Find out about Greek gods and goddesses and create a fact file about one of them.
- Research the Olympic Games in Ancient Greece and design a poster advertising the first Olympics.
- Produce a fact file about a famous Ancient Greek (such as Alexander the Great, Socrates or Archimedes).
- Design a board game or card game based on life in Ancient Greece.
- Write a newspaper report about a famous battle, such as the Battle of Marathon or Thermopylae.
- Write a set of rules for living in an Ancient Greek city-state (Sparta or Athens).
- Make a model of a Greek temple, theatre or a soldier's armour.
- Find out how Ancient Greeks told stories and write your own myth inspired by them.
- Describe what daily life would be like for a child in Athens compared with a child in Sparta.
- Design and label a map of Ancient Greece, showing important cities, trade routes and battles.
